

What is the PRIDE Program?

PRIDE (Probationers in Recovery and Intervention through Drug Education) is a partnership between Mental Health Systems and San Bernardino's Probation Department. We provide outpatient treatment for individuals who have a history of drug/alcohol addiction and criminal activity.

Our treatment includes group therapy, individual sessions, required attendance of three self-help or 12 Step meetings weekly, and regular court appearances to be determined by probation officers. Mental Health Systems is a non-profit agency founded in 1978 to improve the lives of individuals, families and communities facing substance abuse and behavioral health challenges.

What Are Our Services?

Our group services include skill building in areas such as:

- Relapse Prevention
- Socialization
- Family Education
- Early Intervention

Our individual sessions include:

- Intake and Assessment
- Crisis Intervention
- Treatment Planning

Case Management services are provided for:

- Mental Health
- Education
- Employment

Community agencies also provide services onsite on a quarterly basis. Those services can include:

- HIV/AIDS awareness, screening and referral
- Hepatitis C education, screening and referral

How Do We Get Referrals?

All our referrals come from San Bernardino's Probation Department. If you are deemed eligible to receive PRIDE services, your probation officer can make a decision to allow you to enter the program.

Who Do We Serve?

PRIDE provides treatment services to individuals who have been convicted of a crime that can be linked to substance abuse. Referrals from probation are presumed to have a history of drug abuse.

At PRIDE we recognize that many people have individual needs, which may include coping with co-occurring disorders. Our services are aimed at meeting the treatment needs of all those referred to our program through probation.
